

Directions to Manuden Playing Fields (CM23 1DS) approaching from the A10

If you are coming from the Buntingford direction, so from Baldock, Royston etc. and decide to come across country then use **Route 3** below, otherwise stay on the A10 and follow instructions below.

A10 -> Puckeridge

A120 Direction Bishop's Stortford to the roundabout at Tesco's

Then either through Stortford (**Route 1**) or by skirting it on the A120 to the North by turning left at the big roundabout at Tesco's (**Route 2**).

Route 1

If you come through Stortford you have to turn left into Rye Street at the small roundabout when you see the YMCA and Waitrose on the right, car showroom on the left. Continue along this road passing the Bishop's Stortford **Grange Paddocks Playing fields** and **swimming pool** on your right. Continue out of town, Manuden is signposted just as you leave Stortford, as the road starts to take a sharp right turn continue straight ahead passing the restaurant called the Mountbatten (Viceroy's Lounge) (was the Red White and Blue pub) on your right, the road to Manuden is signposted.

Left fork after about a mile - signposted to Manuden.

Continue for 3 or 4 miles into Manuden.

The playing field is on the right and is signposted just before you leave the village to the North - the turning is immediately after a small thatched cottage on the right and opposite another small thatched cottage on the left.

Route 2

If you bypass Stortford to the North then turn right at the roundabout that crosses the B1383 (Bishop's Stortford to Stansted Mountfitchet) towards Stortford.

Immediate right filter - signposted to Manuden.

Sharp right after about 1/4 mile at the restaurant called the Mountbatten (Viceroy's Lounge) (was the Red White and Blue pub) - signposted to Manuden.

Left fork after about a mile - signposted to Manuden.

Continue on the for 3 or 4 miles into Manuden.

The playing field is on the right and is signposted just before you leave the village to the North - the turning is immediately after a small thatched cottage on the right and opposite another small thatched cottage on the left.

Route 3

We usually go across country from here to Buntingford via Clavering but I hesitate to try explain this route - but

At the roundabout on the Buntingford bypass, approaching from Baldock, go straight across into and through Buntingford.

Follow this, it does a sharp right through the town, take the first left direction Hare Street.

At Hare Street you come to a T junction, turn left then immediate right direction Great Hormead.

Stay on this road through Gt. Hormead eventually getting to Brent Pelham, another kind of T junction at which point you turn right, direction Clavering.

Stay on this until you get to Clavering, look out for the right turn in the centre of the village direction Manuden and Bishop's Stortford.

Take care as you approach Manuden, the road is dark and narrow. The playing fields are signposted down the first left turning just before a small thatched cottage.
